**NEW BUSINESS**

a. **Review of proposal for Town attorney services** – Proposal was received from Jay Daigneault, of Frazer Hubbard Brandt Trask Yacavone Metz & Daigneault LLP. The firm’s proposal was to provide legal services anticipating a competitive flat hourly rate with no minimums and no charges for travel time. Present from the firm was Jay Daigneault, who will be handling the town’s legal services. No public discussion. Mayor Simons said that following the April meeting he, Public Works Director Davis and Town Clerk Patrus met with Jim Yacavone and Jay Daigneault to discuss this proposal.

Board discussion covered items #8, the termination clause in the agreement and #9, the additional fee during transition period. Based on present usage and current needs, this arrangement will provide the Town with the greatest value vs. paying a monthly retainer with travel time. Board consensus was to move item to Regular Meeting for adoption.
