**NEW BUSINESS**

**a. NPDES session with Monica Belina of NyPDES** - Ms. Belina has been coordinating the Town’s NPDES permitting process for several years. She related her credentials and resume. The purpose of the workshop was outlined with an agenda. Eric Livingston participated via phone conferencing to answer questions. Handout package and terminology used in the permitting process were reviewed. The main issues covered during the workshop were:

- Fiscal analysis
- Storm water Utility Funding, i.e. staff/projects {example: inspections and maintenance of outfalls]
- Public Outreach
- Annual Training of staff and private contractors
- Private Ponds
- Documentation, reports and analysis
- Future planning for storm water system improvements and for aging infrastructure.

Ms. Belina said the FDEP Manual for NPDES Phase I MS4 permitting resource was available for review. She offered suggestions to the Board, in the event of Director Davis’ retirement, to use the help of interns, seek grants to fund the process and possibly get additional staff. This workshop will be treated as a training session with a sign-in sheet for the record.

**b. FDOT design for Gulf Blvd. Beautification, Pennies for Pinellas Project –**

Mayor Simons said that the schematic each commissioner received was prepared by the FDOT. The Interlocal Agreement with the County Pennys for Pinellas Gulf Beautification money will start being distributed in 2013 over a 7 year time line. Town is allocated \$1,558,300 for this project. As the sketch indicates the project will provide consistency on Gulf Blvd. for pedestrian safety, crosswalks and medians. Board discussion ensued.

Progress Energy has easements along the eastern side of Gulf Blvd. and possibly using the jack/bore method of drilling, some undergrounding of wires can be done. This will certainly be a benefit to the Town. Further discussion can be done in January, 2012 and maybe a workshop. In the interim this will be referred to the Planning Board for review. The Planning Board will be given the original 2006 schematics, the 2008 revision and this present FDOT version.
