**Bon Fire Policies**

1. Bon Fire permits are issued for Redington Beach residents only.
2. No bonfires will be allowed during Turtle Season, May 1<sup>st</sup> – October 31<sup>st</sup>. All fires must be extinguished by midnight. Permit holder must adhere to the noise ordinance, which is 11pm.
3. Location of bonfires shall be exclusive to Beach Park. Residents who reside on the Gulf of Mexico are allowed to have a bonfire at their home with proper permit.
4. The bonfire cannot be within fifty (50) feet of any building. The removal or disturbance of any vegetation on the beach is prohibited.
5. The burning of Christmas trees strictly prohibited.
6. The applicant must contact the Madeira Beach Fire Department (727-391-3400) 24 hours prior to verify wind and weather conditions. Town Hall staff will notify the Pinellas County Sheriff's Office of all bonfire permits.
7. Clean up: The permit holder is responsible for ensuring that any and all fires are completely extinguished prior to leaving the area. The permit holder is solely responsible for ensuring that the area is left clean and clear of any and all debris.
8. The Town reserves the right to refuse a permit for failure to adhere to policy.

**Procedure for obtaining a bonfire permit:**

- Applications are available on our website or can be emailed to applicant upon request.
- Applicant must complete permit form and submit to Town Hall. This can be done electronically via email to [info@townofredingtonbeach.com](mailto:info@townofredingtonbeach.com), by U.S. Mail or in person.
- After application is received by Town Hall, it is signed by a Town Official and sent electronically to the Madeira Beach Fire Department for approval. After the Fire Department Official signs the permit it is then sent electronically to both the applicant and Town Hall.
